Benedetto Molinari is Associate Professor in the Department of Economic Theory and History at the University of Malaga (Malaga, Spain) and Research Fellow at the RCEA (www.rcea.world). His main research interests are Dynamic Macroeconomic Theory, Monetary Economics, Fiscal Policy, Applied Time-series, Macro-Labor and Technical Change. He published in several peer-reviewed journals including The Economic Journal, and his papers are cited in many top journals as the Journal of Economic Surveys, The Economic Journal, AEJ: Macro, Journal of Monetary Economics, NBER working papers, and the Handbook of Social Science.

He earned his Ph.D. in Economics at Universitat Pompeu Fabra (Barcelona, Spain) with a specialization in monetary economics and macroeconomic theory. Later he earned a postdoc (*Beca de Excelencia* issued by Junta de Andalucía) working between 2009 and 2015 in the Department of Economics at the Universidad Pablo de Olavide (Sevilla). In 2016, he moved to the University of Malaga where he's currently working.
